

You must have 23 credits to graduate.

You must have 4 English credits. You can take two English classes in the same year if you have to make up a failed class. You can also make up failed classes through summer school or a fifth year. Other options would need to be negotiated with the Guidance Office prior to the program on a case-by-case basis.

- You must have 3 Math credits – recommended in the first 3 years.
- You must have 3 Social Studies credits: Government, U.S. History and Introduction to Social Sciences.
- You must have 3 Science credits – including Biology or Coastal Ecology and Chemistry.
- You must have 1 Advisor/Advisee credit – $\frac{1}{4}$ credit per year.
- You must have 1 Fine Arts credit.
- You must have 1 Physical Education credit – recommended during the first two years.
- You must have $\frac{1}{2}$ Health credit.
- You must have a minimum of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ elective credits.

In addition, you must meet the standards of the Maine Learning Results.

All students in the class of 2013 and beyond will be required to have earned 23 credits to participate in graduation exercises.

For the classes of 2011 and 2012, 20 credits will still be needed.
