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Admission Procedures

Washington Academy believes that finding a summer study and cultural enrichment program that is the “right fit” for you is a very important educational decision. Based on these criteria, we make a decision on your admission to Washington Academy Summer ESL. The dates of the program are July 26 through August 22, 2008. This program has a limited enrollment and the deadline for applying is May 20, 2008. Applicants are taken after May 20 only if spaces are available. We will notify you as soon as all your information has been received and reviewed. You know you have completed all the requirements, when you have checked off each of the following items:

- Completed and returned the application with a \$2,000 application fee and a picture of yourself.

- Provided your English teacher with the enclosed recommendation and asked him/her to mail the forms directly to us.

- Arranged to have your current school send us a copy of your current transcripts and standardized test scores.

We know that filling out this application takes a great deal of time and thought. We appreciate all your effort. We look forward to reviewing your materials and getting to know you.
